DRUG COURT APPLICATION

Now comes the above captioned defendant and petitions this court to file an application to participate in the DuPage County Drug Court Program; by filing this application the Defendant acknowledges and agrees to the following:

- 1. Defendant must be a resident of DuPage County or as agreed by Drug Court;
2. Defendant shall comply with all assessments and evaluations requested by the DuPage County Drug Court;
3. Defendant shall sign any and all releases of information forms as directed by Probation, including a Consent to Participate in Drug Court;
4. Upon application to Drug Court, the Defendant and the Defendant's attorney authorize the exchange of information between the DuPage County Drug Court Agencies (Program Coordinator, Department of Probation and Court Services, Public Defender's Office and State's Attorney's Office), designated treatment providers and related agencies as is necessary to determine eligibility for the Drug Court Program;
5. Defendant must have health care benefits or health insurance or enroll for coverage under the Affordable Care Act;
6. Defendants on bond shall attend and actively participate in all pre-treatment groups through Probation. Defendants in custody shall attend and actively participate with JUST programing by requesting to be considered for the Recovery Pod in the DuPage County Jail, as directed by Probation or the Court;
7. Defendant shall not ingest alcohol or drugs;
8. Defendant shall submit to any and all chemical testing or urinalysis requested by DuPage County Drug Court and understands that if the results are positive for any alcohol or drugs, including over the counter medication not approved by the Drug Court Probation Officer, he/she can be taken into custody;
9. Defendant shall not posses any firearms or dangerous weapons from the time of the application through the conclusion of his/her participation in Drug Court;
10. Defendant waives any speedy trial rights he/she may otherwise have during the pendency of this application.
11. The Probation Department shall complete a Criminal History Report.
