## ORDER

This matter coming on pursuant to 430 ILCS 65/10(c), and the Court hearing relevant argument and evidence in the premises, hereby finds and orders:

- 1. The petitioner/applicant has petitioned the circuit court in the county where the petitioner/applicant resides, requesting relief from a denial of a FOID card by the Illinois State Police.
- 2. The State's Attorney has been served with a written copy of the petition at least 30 days before the hearing in the circuit court.
- 3. At the hearing the State's Attorney was afforded an opportunity to present evidence and object to the petition.
- 4 The petitioner/applicant has not been convicted of a forcible felony under the laws of this State or any other jurisdiction within 20 years of the applicant's application for a Firearm Owner's Identification Card, or at least 20 years have passed since the end of any period of imprisonment imposed in relation to that conviction.
- 5. The Court has considered the circumstances regarding a criminal conviction.
- 6. The Court has considered the petitioner/applicant's criminal history.
- 7. The Court has considered the petitioner/applicant's reputation.

- 8. The Court finds that the petitioner/applicant will not be likely to act in a manner dangerous to public safety.
- 9. The Court finds that granting relief would not be contrary to the public interest.
- 10 The Court finds that granting relief would not be contrary to federal law.

Wherefore, the Director of the Illinois State Police is hereby directed to rescind its denial of a Firearm Owner's Identification Card, and to instead issue a Firearm Owner's Identification Card to \_\_\_\_\_\_.
