CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

- 1. Obey all State, Federal laws and local ordinances.
2. Immediately notify your Probation Officer if arrested for any reason.
3. Report in person to your Probation Officer as frequently as directed, and permit your Probation Officer to visit you in your home or elsewhere, and be cooperative and truthful with your Probation Officer in all matters.
4. Inform your Probation Officer in writing, within seven (7) days, of any change of employment or place of residence.
5. Do not leave the State of Illinois without advance notice and written permission from your Probation Officer.
6. Appear before the Court in person as directed by your Probation Officer or the Court.
7. Work at a lawful occupation, and/or further your education, and support your dependents.
8. Refrain from possessing a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
9. The Department of Probation and Court Services is hereby authorized to divulge information from its records to comply with this Court Order.
10. Pay a Probation fee of \$25.00 or \$_____ each month.
11. Pay all fines, costs, fees, penalties and restitution in full not less than sixty (60) days before the end of probation in equal monthly installments.
12. Undergo random urinalysis testing in a manner set forth by the Probation Department and pay for a minimum of two (2) tests per year at a rate of \$15.00 per test. Refusal to be tested and/or positive results will be considered a violation of your probation.
13. Promptly undertake evaluations as determined appropriate by the Probation Department and thereafter successfully complete such treatment, therapy, counseling and/or remedial education as ordered by the Probation Department. Refusal to participate, or withdrawal or discharge from any of the above programs, will be considered a violation of your Probation.
14. Upon violation of the terms and conditions of this order, the Probation Department may invoke sanctions from the list of administrative sanctions adopted by the Chief Judge.
15. Complete _____ hours of Public Service as arranged through the Probation Department.
