What is TechShare?

TechShare is a web-based solution that streamlines discovery on a case. Digital multimedia evidence (photo, video, audio, etc.) eliminates discs and paper documents since discovery is now available on-line.

When can I register?

Defense attorneys can register now at the following URL: https://illinois-defense.cuc.org

What are the steps for registering?

- 1. Navigate to TechShare.Defense: https://illinois-defense.cuc.org
- 2. Select "Create Account".
- 3. Login with your username and password to request access.
- 4. Defense attorneys will be notified by email once access has been granted by the DuPage County State's Attorney's Office.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can someone in my firm register on my behalf?

Yes, one person such as a secretary or paralegal may register one or multiple users within a single firm.

Attorneys may also delegate shared access to another person such as a paralegal or an investigator on any given case.

How long will it take for my account to be approved before I have access to my cases?

The DuPage County State's Attorney's Office will approve or deny access no later than 48 hours from the initial request.

What information do I need to provide to register for an account?

Defense attorneys will be required to provide basic information such as full name, ARDC#, email, address, firm name (if applicable) and phone number.

Do I need to download software to use TechShare.Defense?

No, the application is web-based and is accessible from any device with a stable Internet connection.
